### Trainings

As a Landing Rental Assistant, you will participate in an on-site safety training session and approximately 1-2 weeks of training shifts. All training sessions will be scheduled by management based on staff availability, need and weather conditions.

### Schedule

Full time, seasonal Landing Rental Assistants work 5-6 days per week. You can expect 4-6 hours of scheduled landing shifts per day. Given the seasonal & outdoor nature of this job, days are dependent on weather & interest, with highest hours expected in the Spring, Summer & Fall months.
